Yellowstone Airport (WYS) is seeing some improvements at the Pilot Campground. Foremost, the airport is in the process of acquiring a brand-new outhouse building. The new building will be made of concrete similar to many of those at United State Forest Service Campgrounds through-out the state.

The airport is also in the process of installing two new picnic tables for the campground pavilion. These picnic tables will be made of treated wood and will be ADA compliant. Contributions for the tables were provided by Montana Pilot's Association (MPA), and Recreation Aviation Foundation (RAF), and pilot campground donations.
